

Jensen Beach Art League
Meeting Minutes
November 11, 2022

All are encouraged to "recruit" and "advertise" the Jensen Beach Art League as much as possible, wherever possible.

Exhibiting Report: We are anticipating 10-11 tents to be set up this Sunday for the Museum exhibit. Various signs are to be put up, and several windsocks will be flying to attract attention.

Art Education:
